ARE YOU THINKING OF HAVING A QUINCEAÑERA CELEBRATION?



Holy Family Church's Quinceañera policies and celebrations have changed due to the high demand of dates requested, which take away from ordinary sacraments, such as marriages. Quinceañeras will now be celebrated in multiples of three (3) per Mass. They will only be celebrated on the first and fourth Saturday of each month at 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon, effective June 2008. The Quinceañera participant must attend two classes and two retreats in order to book the Mass. At these classes/retreats, the participants will be properly instructed in the cultural and religious traditions of the Quinceañera. After finishing the course, a certificate will be granted. This must be given to the Parish where the Mass of Quinceañera will be celebrated. The next parent orientation day is scheduled for Saturday, January 12, 2008, at 7:00 p.m. in room 5. This is to book a Quinceañera celebration between June 2008 and December 2008. Please stop by the parish office to register for this orientation.
